smarter hair removal

Sydney beauty salon-owner **Olimpia Zajac**, spoke to Anila Azhar about permanent hair reduction using smartPULS with Constant Multi Pulse technology.

Fortunately for many people, the latest in Intense Pulsed Light (IPL) technologies can put a stop to routine shaving and waxing – all within a few visits to the salon. Traditionally IPL technologies use light energy to gently remove unwanted hair, and its wide beam means larger areas can be treated at a time.

Among the array of IPL technologies on offer, is smartPULS technology distributed by the CPL Group. The smartPULS product is described as an advanced IPL system using Constant Multi Pulse (CMP) technology for the treatment of permanent hair reduction, skin rejuvenation and instant wrinkle reduction. According to Sydney beauty salon-owner Olympia Zajac smartPULS, is one of the latest products on the market and is producing a very positive result. Zajac says smartPULS is gentle and is relatively safe, compared to many existing laser hair removal technologies.

CMP technology, manufactured in Germany, allows the operator to steer the light with an even distribution, close to the optimum output wave. The technology produces wavelengths between 530nm and 1900nm and each pulse is controlled or maintained digitally with a rate of more than 20,000 scans per second. This allows the operator to split the original pulse into double, triple even quad shots,

allowing the operator to adjust the energy to the client's needs and comfort.

The smartPULS offers advanced digital touch screen technology, a security user code and a simple menu structure. The digital control of the light is essentially the difference between CMP technology and the traditional IPL system.

'By controlling the quantum of energy smartPULS provides better comfort and greater treatment results,' Zajac says. 'What's more the smartPULS does not require extra filters.'

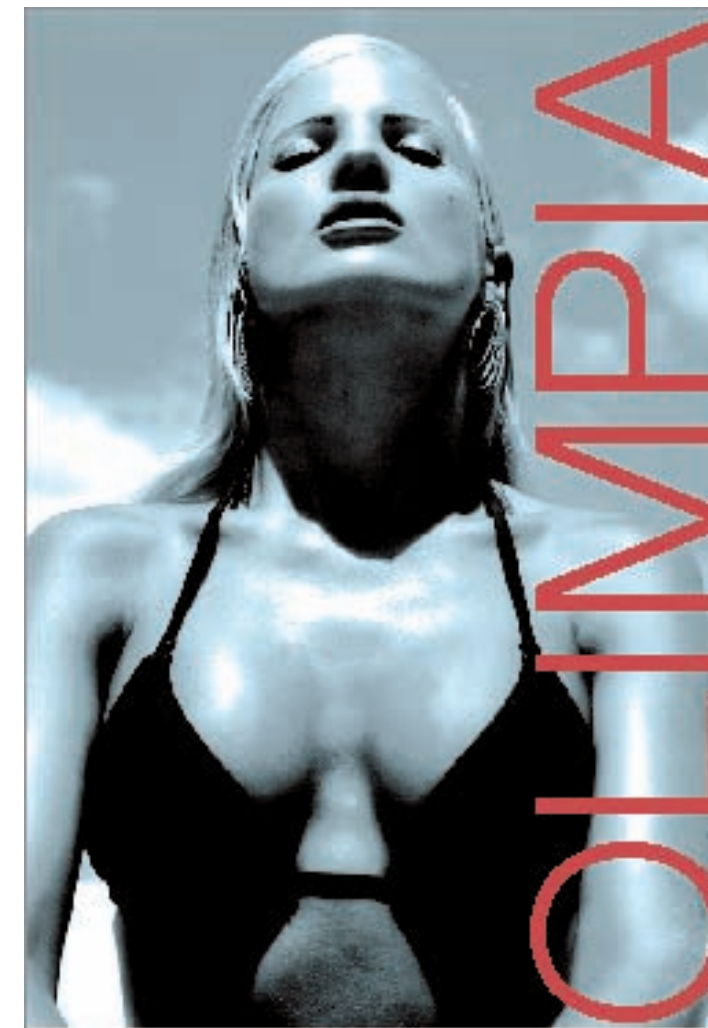

As well as the treatment of permanent hair reduction and skin rejuvenation, the smartPULS can also be used for the treatment of pigmented lesions, skin tightening, vascular lesions, acne scars and stretch marks, according to Zajac. More customers are seeking a fresh appearance and are in search of gentle forms of procedures, says Zajac.

Wrinkles develop due to lack of collagen of the skin. And when the skin loses its elasticity, fine lines may begin to appear and the skin texture may become rough. SmartPULS, using CMP technology, offers clients treatments to reform the collagen through a micro-thermal trauma between dermis and epidermis. This triggers the skin to form collagen during the healing process. **acsm**
